Syllabus (CBCS)

B.A. Honours in Sanskrit

(6 Semesters Pattern)

There will be six semesters in the three-year B.A. Honours in Sanskrit. The Curriculum consists of 14 Core Courses (DC), 2 Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AEC), 2 Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) and 4 Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Courses and 4 Generic Elective (GE) courses [to be taken from the pool of Generic Elective Courses]. Each course is of 50 marks.

- 1. 40% of Questions are to be answered compulsory in Sanskrit in 1st and 2nd Semester.**
- 2. 50% of Questions are to be answered compulsory in Sanskrit in 3rd and 4th Semester.**
- 3. 60% Questions to be answered compulsory in Sanskrit in 5th and 6th Semester.**
