

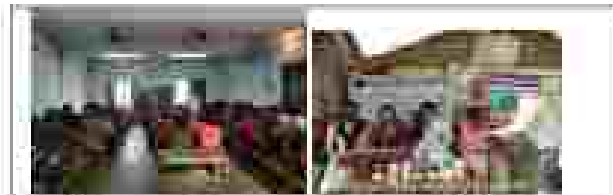

STRATEGY DEVELOPMENT AND DEPLOYMENT

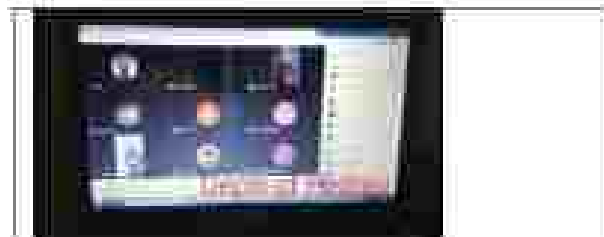

4. Evaluation Process and Reforms

2.5.1. Mechanism of internal assessment is transparent and robust in terms of frequency and mode:

Response: Response: The college has transparent and robust evaluation process in terms of frequency and variety. Schedule of Tutorial examinations and internal assessment examination is given in Academic calendar which is displayed well in advance before commencement of session. Students are assessed continuously through various evaluation processes at college and University level. Continuous evaluation is made through Group Discussion, Unit Tests, Assignments Submission, Field Visit / Field Work(Education, Geography, History, Sociology) and Seminars Presentation. We conduct 1 tutorial, 1 internal assessment, class test and viva voce per paper. Unit tests are conducted regularly as per the schedule given in academic calendar. In case of internal tutorial and internal assessment examinations usually four faculty members check and evaluate one single paper. At the end of each examination, the Principal verifies the internal marks of all the students. Marks are displayed in the notice board. In case of final examination, the Controller of Examinations, University of GourBanga, Malda, issues appointment letters to the teachers for paper setting , moderation ,and evaluation of answer scripts. Online examination system has been introduced both by the Controller of Examinations,

University of Gour Banga, and the authority of GourMahavidyalaya, Mangalbari, Mlida, since 2019. Unsuccessfull students or unsatisfied students can apply for reassessment and scrutiny.
