(c) How is the concept of *Nada* presented in Ernest Hemingway's novel *A Farewell to Arms*? Discuss.

(d) Can Catherine Barkley be considered a tragic heroine? Justify your response with suitable examples.

(e) How does F. Scott Fitzgerald's "The Crack-Up" connect to the author's personal life? Discuss.

Or,

(f) Discuss William Faulkner's "Dry September" as a critique of racism.

(g) What elements of Americanness do you trace in Walt Whitman's poetry? Discuss with reference to his poems on your syllabus.

(h) Critically estimate Sherman Alexie's "Evolution".

(e) What is the allusion used in the last part of "The Purloined Letter"?

Or,

(f) Mention two images of horror and violence found in the opening paragraph of "Dry September".

(g) "Love is a naked shadow On a gnarled and naked tree" — Locate and explain.

(h) What is the significance of the allusion to the 'Episode of Revelation' at the end of the poem, "Crow Testament"?
