


INTRODUCTION:MOTTO: NOT ME,BUT YOU

The National Service Scheme is a programme conducted by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports ,Government of India.. Popularly known as NSS, the scheme was launched in Gandhiji's Centenary year in 1969. On 24 September 1969, the then Union Education Minister V.K.R.V.Rao launched the NSS at universities and colleges in all states. The Motto of NSS "Not Me But You", reflects the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for selfless service. NSS helps the students to develop their moral character and serve the common people and the Nation.

SYMBOL

The symbol for the NSS has been based on the giant Rath Wheel of the world-famous Konark Sun Temple(Orissa, India). The wheel portrays the cycle of creation, preservation and release. It signifies the movement in life across time and space, the symbol thus stands for continuity as well as change and implies the continuous striving of NSS for social change. The eight bars in the wheel represents 24 hours of a day. The red colour indicates that the volunteer is full of young blood that is lively, active, energetic and full of high spirit. The navy blue colour indicates the cosmos of which the NSS is tiny part, ready to contribute its share for the welfare of the mankind. It stands for continuity as well as change and implies the continuous striving of NSS for social transformation and uplift.

OBJECTIVES:

- (1). Student's service for the cause of community and the Nation.
- (2).Develop among the volunteers a sense of social and civic responsibility.
- (3).Gain skills in mobilizing community participation.
- (4).Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in the solutions of the problems.
- (5).Develop competence required for collective existence and sharing of responsibilities.

One of the objectives is to develop the moral character of the students through community service and establish a linkage between the college campus and village community. The other objective is to implement service learning technique through community service. One of the object is to implement service learning technique. Community service programmes provide a link between the college and the rural society. Service learning is a set of techniques and tools that can strengthen community relationship. It helps the volunteers to build their character and enhances the sense of civic responsibility.
