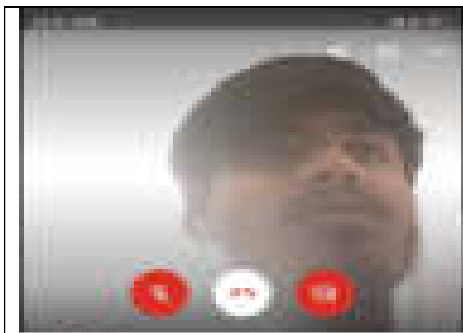

**Rajadipta Roy** teaches English Literature at Maynaguri College, Jalpaiguri, West Bengal. He talked about Identity Politics of North Bengal.

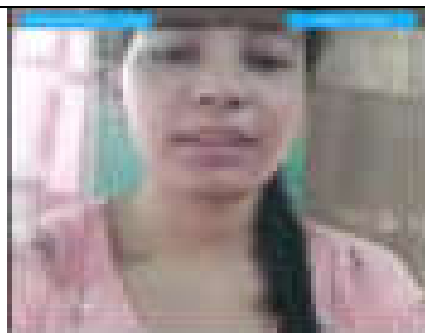
