Nazrul Islam, the renowned Bengali poet was also a journalist, a musician, a lyricist and a commentator on public events. While dominant writing on Nazrul focused on his poetic personae and his rebellious spirit, his journalistic writings went unnoticed. This seminar proposes to discuss Nazrul's journalistic writings. Nazrul did not shy away from commenting on the atrocities of the colonial rule as well as on the Hindu-Muslim divide. This seminar, therefore, highlights Nazrul as a public intellectual- someone commenting on the public issues affecting the society and culture of the then India. This seminar also seeks to understand the relevance of Nazrul's views today.



Outcome of the Seminar


