# YOUTH PARLIAMENT COMPETITION

ACHIEVEMENTS AND SUCCESS BY THE THE COLLEGE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE



In order to imbibe the concepts of Parliamentary democracy and to inculcate the parliamentary practices and procedures in the young minds, the Government of India introduced the "Youth Parliament Competition Scheme" in educational institutions following the recommendation of the Fourth All India Whips Conference held at Bombay in 1962 and its subsequent reiteration in 1966. From the year 1994-95, the Government of West Bengal initiated the scheme for its implementation in educational institutions of the State. Since then, the Parliamentary Affairs Department has been organizing "Youth Parliament Competition Scheme" in order to make students understand the parliamentary procedure and develop an insight into the working of parliament. It is also aimed at training students in the techniques of group discussion and to develop in them respect and tolerance for the views of others. Above all, it intends to develop in students the quality of leadership. The ultimate objective is to strengthen the fundamentals of Parliamentary democracy in the country. Over the past few years, the ambit of the scheme has been much broadened. The competition is now being held at the level of Block/Municipality, District and finally at the division/state level.



YPC is an annual event organized by the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, Government of West Bengal. The competition for colleges takes place at three levels, starting at the District level, followed by the Division level, and then the State level. It consists of various events such as parliamentary quiz, quiz on character building, extempore competition, and essay writing competition. The competition aims to encourage young people to develop their communication and leadership skills while gaining valuable insights into a parliamentary democracy.

### Our achievements over the years:

Gour Mahavidyalaya has been a consistent performer in the Youth Parliament Competition. In 2014, the college won the Champion title in both District and Division level, demonstrating its excellence in parliamentary procedure and public speaking skills. The victory was a testament to the hard work and dedication of the college's faculty and students.

We consecutively secured 2nd position in 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16 session. But then 2nd position holdr was not eligible for next level.

In 2017-18, Gour Mahavidyalaya stood 2nd (1st runner up) among 11 colleges of Malda district and secured two individual prizes (Best Leader of Opposition and Best Lady Parliamentarian) in the District Level Youth Parliament Competition held at Kaliachak College on 02.11.2017. We also got Rs. 40000/- as prize money. Hence, we have qualified for the next level that is Divisional level. At Divisional level we secured the 1st position (Champion) among the 8 colleges from four districts of Malda Division. We also got Rs. 100000/- as prize money. As a result, we qualified for the State Level. At State level we have secured two individual prizes (Best Parliamentarian and Best Lady Parliamentarian)

In 2018-2019, our college again secured 2nd position (1st runner up) among 11 colleges of Malda district and secured one individual prize (Best Parliamentarian) in the District Level Youth Parliament Competition held at Manikchak College on 09.11.2019. We also got Rs. 40000/- as prize money. Hence, we have qualified for the next level that is Divisional level. At Divisional level we secured the 3rd position among the 8 colleges from four districts of Malda Division. We also got Rs. 60000/- as prize money.

In 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 session the competition has not been held due to COVID-19 pandemic.

In 2021-2022, after the pandemic the competition resumed again. Our college again secured 2nd position (1st runner up) among 11 colleges of Malda district and secured one individual prize (Best Parliamentarian) in the District Level Youth Parliament Competition held at Gour Mahavidyalaya on 15.09.2022. We also got Rs. 60000/- as prize money. Hence, we have qualified for the next level that is Divisional level. At Divisional level we secured the 1st position among the 8 colleges from four districts of Malda Division and secured two individual prizes (Best Speaker and Best Secretary)

Sri Arup Kr Roy, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science, with the help of other faculty members of the Department guiding the YPC team of the college since 2017. Sri Arup Kr Roy won Best Script Writer prize in at the Divisional Level YPC held at Balurghat, Dakshin Dinajpur, in the session 2022-23.


