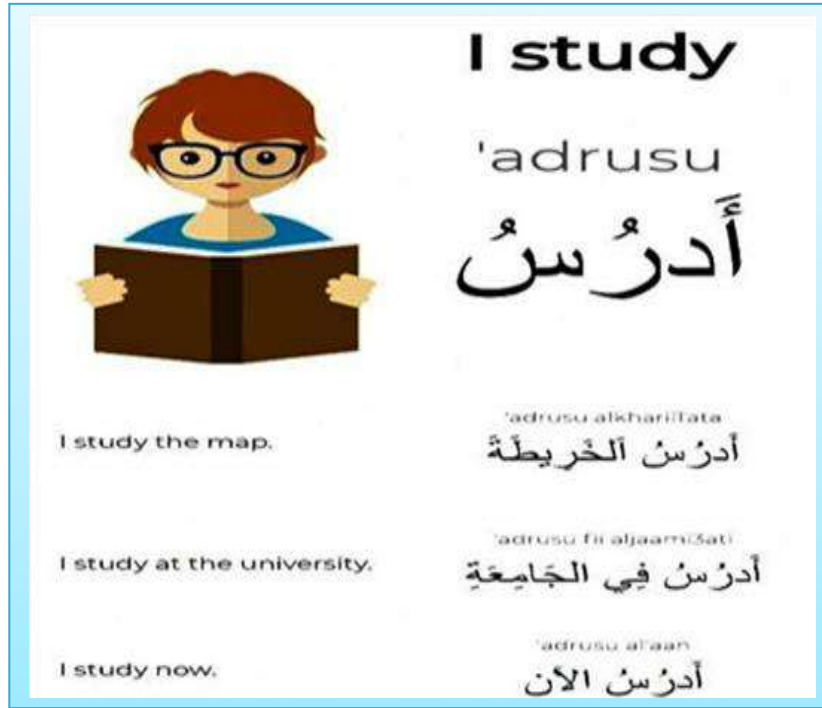


# GOUR MAHAVIDYALAYA, MANGALBARI, MALDA

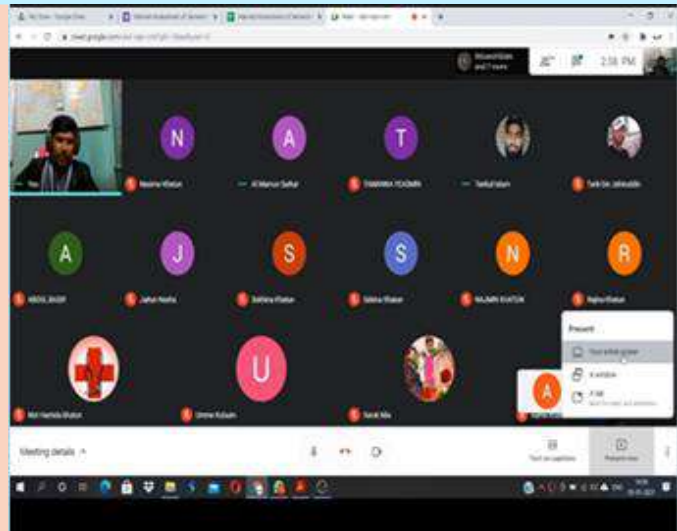

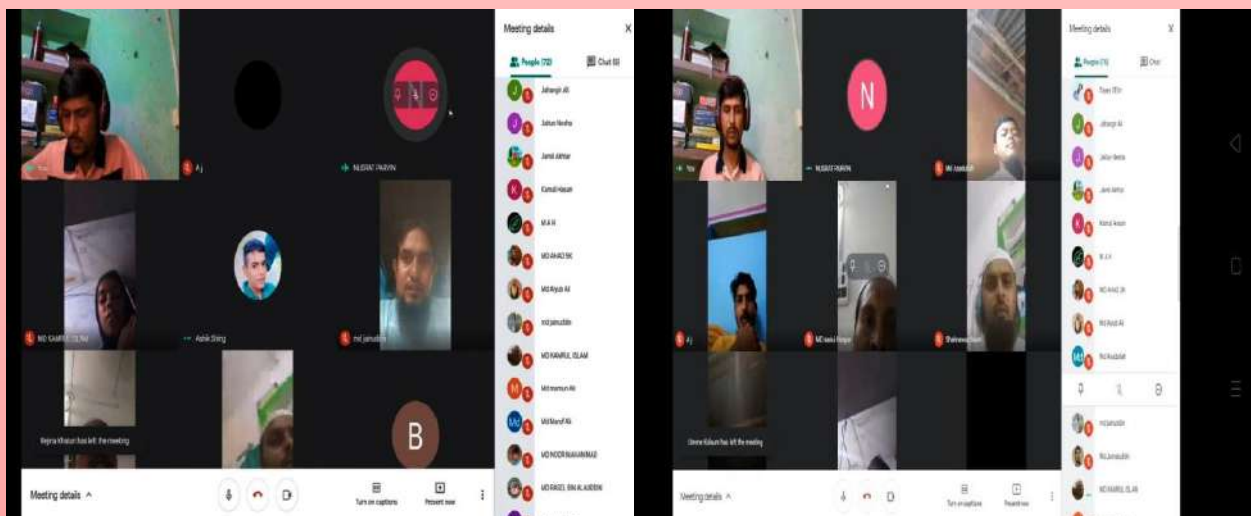
