CONCEPT NOTE:

Violence has become a pervasive theme in contemporary literature and cinema: a reflection of anxieties, conflicts, and disillusionments within modern societies. This topic examines how various forms of violence—whether physical, psychological, political, and structural are represented and mediated through literature and cinema. It examines how authors or film directors glorify or criticize violence in terms of evoking our empathy, provoking thought and perceptions. In literature, depictions often interrogate language, morality, and trauma; in cinema, it visualizes brutality through both realism and stylization. The study further considers how media technologies and global politics shape the audience's perception of violence. Why does every contemporary director choose this genre? And why do these violent movies become so popular? In the end, the purpose of this topic is to determine whether such representations desensitize or sensitize viewers and to understand the ethical responsibilities artists bear in relation to their portrayals of human suffering.
