

1	How are your courses managed?	The courses are managed through traditional lecture method, through virtua learning classrooms and ICT enabled classes. Online classes were conducted during the pandemic with the help of Google Classroom, Google Meet platform etc.

3	How is teaching and learning organised for students?	Before initiation of each academic session, the Academic Council frames the Academic Calendar on the basis of the input received from each department. The Central Class Routine is prepared following the University guidelines. The Calendar is then circulated along with the PSOs and Cos to each faculty followed by the collection of teacher-wise syllabus distribution and curriculum planning.

4	What pedagogical approaches are used?	As set forth by the UGC, the State Government and the affiliating University from time to time.

As part of the student counselling, an Induction Programme is arranged at the beginning of each session, followed by a "Profile mapping". Apart from these each department conducts Remedial Classes along with Mentor-mented programme to enhance the issues of student participation and enhancement.
6	What resources are used in teaching andlearning?	Text and reference books, journals, e-resources, lectures, films, multimedia, digital learning resources tools like ICT are frequently used by the faculties.
