Before initiation of each academic session, the Academic Council frames the Academic Calendar on the basis of the input received from each department. The Central Class Routine is prepared following the University guidelines. The Calendar is then circulated along with the PSOs and Cos to each faculty followed by the collection of teacher-wise syllabus distribution and curriculum planning.

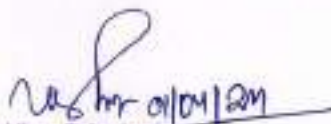

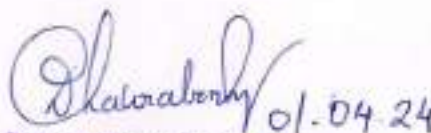
